Greetings all,

It has been an interesting start to the year, with our new larger tent designs featured in our previous newsletter and now with the release of our new Budget Serengeti Tents.

The new [Budget Serengeti](#) was designed to be a lower cost alternative to the Serengeti Tent. The Budget Serengeti tent comes in only two sizes:

4-Leg Frame

6.3m x 4.6m Overall Footprint      20' 8" x 15' 2"

3.5m x 3.5m Living Area            11' 5" x 11' 5"

1.2m x 3.5m Bathroom Extension   6' 10" x 3' 9"

5-Leg Frame

8.4m x 4.6m Overall Footprint      27' 6" x 15' 2"

4.6m x 3.5m Living Area            15' 2" x 11' 5"

1.2m x 3.5m Bathroom Extension   6' 10" x 3' 9"




What makes these two tents different is that it does not require a platform as the other tents do and can thus be set up directly on the ground.

The tents only come with mild galvanized steel frames, canvas rain fly, no shade fly, medium duty canvas body, stitched in ground sheet, zip on/off bathroom, stitched in zips, inner window storm flaps, pegs and are all olive in color - more details can be found in the drawings on the [website](#).

Both tents are standard and cannot be changed or modified in any way.

Manufacturing lead time for these tents is 10-12 weeks at this time with only 20 of the smaller tents and 30 of the larger units being manufactured in the first production run so quantities will be limited to a total of 50 units for awhile.



The bathroom section can be zipped on or off as desired and the stitched in ground sheet is heavy duty. The zip open door into the bathroom can be seen in the picture above.

Doors and windows are also all screened and the space between the fly and inner roof allows for airflow and natural cooling. The tent itself is also vented in the apex of the inner roof.

We also have two new classic Campaign and Safari chairs, the Rookhee chair which collapses into a hand carry bundle and the Lagos chair that simply folds up.




Rookhee




Lagos



Lastly we have a really unique new tent concept to be called the [Gomondwane Tent](#) named after another of the legendary elephants of the [Kruger National Park](#).



Though this is a rather basic design of a half circle but it can be put together in numerous ways to make up a variety of different alternative tent designs that can be seen in the image below. The basic design is not small in itself at 68.8sqm (740 sq ft) but in the various combinations they can produce very spacious and unusual looking tents. These tent combinations should be available for order in early June..



Not much is known about the elephant Gomondwane, he was first recorded by guests to the Kruger National Park in 1992, and seen subsequently on occasion during the annual aerial census in the Southern Region of the Kruger National Park.
